BLOXWORTH HALL

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Your watch is designed for daily use and has been through rigorous testing including pressure tests at 200m in water so it's safe to say you can do pretty much anything with it.

After around three years, you'll notice the seconds hand on the Swiss movement will jump in 4 second intervals. This is the low power indicator letting you know it's time for a new battery. Make sure whoever replaces your battery pressure tests your watch afterwards to ensure it's waterproof, or you can return it to us and we can take care of it for you.

If your watch gets muddy, dusty, or is used in salt water, give it a rinse under running water to keep the bezel rotating freely, and then dry it off.

5 YEAR GUARANTEE

Our warranty is honest and straightforward: if your watch develops a fault within 5 years of the original date of purchase because of a manufacturing defect, we'll put it right for you free of charge.

Our warranty doesn't cover crystals, batteries, straps and buckles, theft, loss, damage resulting from misuse, negligence, accidents, improper use (blows, shocks, crushing, dents, scratches etc), 3rd party repairs/servicing, or wear and tear.

We don't warranty crystals and straps because although we build and test our watches up to a high standard, the lifespan of these components is dependent on the conditions and type of wear & tear the watch is subjected to.

## EASY STRAP CHANGES

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Place the tool provided into the petal shaped socket in the end of the strap bar, making sure it can't pop out, and turn it anticlockwise to undo the bar.

Undo the bar until you can see the threaded end and then give the bar a wiggle and then you should be able to easily pull the bar out by pulling on the thread.

Please note that the thread will only protrude 2-3mm when fully unscrewed.

To fit the new strap, locate the strap against the watch and insert the strap bar. You might need to give the bar and strap a wiggle to align it with the hole in the case.

Gently push the bar through the strap until the screw thread on the bar reaches the watch.

Now carefully screw the bar back into the watch using the included tool, ensuring the bar isn't cross-threaded.

As soon as the bar starts to 'nip up' be careful not to over tighten it.

If it won't screw in, wiggle the strap whilst pushing the end of the bar to help locate the bar in the other side of the watch.

LUMINOSITY



The SuperLuminova paint on the hands, dial, and bezel is white by day and glows a cool blue at night.

It will glow for up to 8 hours as long as it's seen plenty of daylight.

If your watch has been under a garment all day it won't glow as brightly as the paint needs to absorb light during the day in order to glow at night.

BEZEL

The external timing bezel can easily be rotated to align the 12 o'clock pip with the minutes hand to time an event.

From there it's easy to count the event time as it elapses using the markings on the bezel. Alternatively you could set the 12 o'clock pip say 30 minutes ahead and count down to that moment.

The bezel can only rotate anticlockwise, so that it can only show a shorter time remaining if it's knocked accidentally, a feature originally developed for safety when scuba diving.



ADJUSTING THE TIME AND DATE



## DATE

Pull the crown out gently until you feel it click into position **I**. Now turn it until the calendar shows yesterday's date.

## TIME

Now pull it out gently to the next click (position **II**), and adjust the time so that the calendar flicks over to today's date. Your watch is now at midnight last night. Carry on winding the hands forwards to the correct time then push the crown all the way in when you're done.

If you're setting your watch after 12 noon, you will first need to wind the hands round 12 hours, then to the correct PM time.

Try not to adjust the time between 9pm and midnight, as the calendar is starting to change the date between those times.

The seconds-hand stops when the crown is pulled out to position II so you can synchronise the time exactly or extend the battery life if you need to store your watch long-term.

Once the time and date are correct, push the crown fully in until it touches the case and your watch is waterproof.

CARING FOR YOUR WATCH

It's tough, but it's assembled from precision components built to exacting tolerances, so avoid really hard impacts.

Give it a rinse after use in salt water or if it gets dirty and ensure that the bezel rotates freely, then dry it off with a soft cloth.

If you think your watch has developed a problem, please get in touch so that we can check it over. Please do not remove the case back, so that we can examine it in exactly the same condition as when the fault arose. Removing the case back will invalidate the warranty.

When the battery on your watch starts to run low, the seconds hand will begin to jump in 4 second intervals. It will do this for a month or so to let you know your watch needs a battery change.

When the battery is replaced, your watch will need to be pressure tested afterwards to ensure it's waterproof.

We can do this for you, or if you choose to take your watch elsewhere, please ensure the watchmaker is able to pressure-test it for you.

FEATURES AND HIGHLIGHTS

If you're interested in what makes your Elliot Brown tick, here are the highlights:

## CASE DESIGN

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Every part of your watch case is made from 316L stainless steel. 316L is highly durable, takes all our detailing beautifully, and is hypo-allergenic, so no nasty rashes.

316L is often called marine grade stainless steel, because it's unaffected by sea water, even long term. Give it a rinse and it's as good as new.

The case back is bolted down not screwed on so that the waterproofing seals are clamped and aren't twisted, and to ensure the logo is always perfectly vertical.

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## WATER RESISTANCE

Your watch has been manufactured to ISO 2281 for water resistance, and although it's not required for ISO 2281, every single one of our watches

is pressure tested individually to 150m/15ATM, twice in air pressure. Then it undergoes a 200m pressure test in water for 10 minutes to make absolutely certain that it's fit for purpose.

## GLASS

The domed sapphire glass is incredibly scratch resistant, and has an anti-reflective coating on the inside to maximise visibility and minimise reflections.

It's this anti-reflective coating that produces the blue tint you can sometimes see, and we only apply it to the inside of the glass, so you don't get annoying fingerprints and scratches in the coating.

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## DIAL

The dual layer dial is polished to produce a perfectly flat piano gloss surface with some models being made from mother of pearl.

The 3D hours markers are polished and then flooded with white SuperLuminova that glows blue at night, providing the best possible legibility in low light.

## BEZEL

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The divers bezel has fine coin edged grooves around its circumference echoing the design of classic dive watches for confident grip in all conditions.

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## MOVEMENT

We chose a Swiss made Ronda movement for your watch because they're proven high quality movements

that are maintainable long-term. The 3 year battery life and its end-of-life indicator means your battery won't run out unexpectedly.

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## STRAPS

All our rubber straps are pre-curved to fit your wrist perfectly with no tight spots.

Our custom made bracelets can easily be adjusted for a perfect fit by removing the screw-in bars that join the links together using the screwdriver included.

If you fancy a change, all the straps in the Hali range will fit your watch with quick and easy changes thanks to the simple screw-in bar system using the tool included with your watch.

All of our straps are hypoallergenic and all except the leather straps are designed for use in and around water.

## RECYCLING

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Our in-house service department can keep your watch ticking indefinitely but if you do decide to recycle it, we have chosen to group together with other retailers in joining the 'Distributor Take Back Scheme'. Through this scheme, we have paid toward the provision of improved recycling facilities for our customers.

Customers will be able to take any old electrical equipment to participating civic amenity sites (household waste

civic amenity sites (household waste recycling centres) run by their local councils. Funding collected through the Distributor Take Back Scheme has been distributed between all the local authorities in the UK to ensure the provision of improved recycling facilities. Producers of these products will then ensure that deposited items are taken away and recycled.
